

## RESOLUTION

At the regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Rico, State of Colorado, duly convened and held on the 9th day of January, 1960, the following resolution was duly passed, approved and adopted:

Motion was made by Trustee Fahrion that the following resolution be passed, adopted and approved by the Trustee:

BE IT RESOLVED that, WHEREAS the Town of Rico, Colorado, being advised by the Board of County Commissioners of Dolores County, State of Colorado, that there are not sufficient mines operating, especially during the winter months, in the Rico District for it to be practical for the County of Dolores, State of Colorado, to maintain the necessary equipment and road crew in the Rico District to make certain improvements and to maintain said roads in the Rico District, which Rico District includes approximately twenty-six (26) miles of road. AND WHEREAS it is of vital importance to the care, health and welfare of the inhabitants of the Town of Rico that said roads be maintained.

AND WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners for Dolores County, State of Colorado, has suggested that the Town of Rico enter into an agreement with the County of Dolores, for maintenance of said roads.

NOW BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board that the Mayor of the Town of Rico is hereby directed and authorized to enter into the following agreement with the County of Dolores for the improvement and maintenance of County roads in the Rico District:

That the County of Dolores shall pay to the Town of Rico the sum of Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) each month from January 1, 1960 to January 1, 1961. That the Town of Rico shall furnish a tractor for the improvement and maintenance of said roads in the Rico District, and that the Town of Rico shall furnish the operator therefor, and fuel for the operation of same.

That the Town of Rico shall cause maintenance on said roads to be performed not less than twice yearly and to perform some improvement on the Scotch Creek Road to east county line, provided such improvement does not require work to exceed four (4) days.

The County of Dolores shall furnish at the site needed any and all powder, culverts and all necessary materials for opening, maintaining and improving said Scotch Creek Road.

That the Town of Rico shall be responsible for carrying proper workman's compensation insurance coverage for its operator of said tractor together with liability insurance to protect the
