

Resolution No. 103

(For the Use of Community Center)

At the regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Rico, Colorado for the month of August 6, 1982. The following Resolution was passed, adopted, and approved.

Whereas all requests by group, except local organization for this facility must be made to the Rico Town Clerk in writing two weeks before scheduled event.

Whereas a deposit of \$50.00 must be made for one days use when reservation is confirmed. \$15.00 will be refunded if hall is cleaned up and there are no damages to facilities.

Whereas when the kitchen is to be used, a request must be made with the President or Vice-President of the Rico Women's Club and arrangements made with this group for the use of these facilities.

Whereas if alcoholic beverages are to be served, it must be consumed in the rooms that are reserved for the activity or completely off the premises. There will be no drinking on the main floor, basement, stairways, hall or porch.

Whereas the courthouse is an old Historical Landmark there will be absolutely no smoking allowed with in the building.

Now therefore be it resolved that the Town Clerk will be responsible for making the arrangements for the activity, open the door and arrange for closing when the event is over. The Town Clerk will prepare the bathrooms and arrange for check ins by the Rico Town Marshal when deemed advisable by the Rico Town Board.
